Why take the Bar exam?

- **Become a Solicitor in England & Wales without having to secure a training contract**
By passing the NY Bar exam, LLB students become eligible to undertake the Qualified Lawyers Transfer Scheme (QLTS) to become a Solicitor of England & Wales.
- **Work in the US**
Upon successfully passing either the New York or California State Bar and securing a pass in the MPRE exam, you are eligible to apply for admittance to its State Bar and commence work as an attorney.
- **Enhance your career prospects in the UK**
There are many US law firms in the UK. You may already work for one of them or may wish to. Passing the Bar exam will assist on both counts.

Whatever your reason for considering a Bar exam, it will widen the opportunities available to you.

Am I eligible?

New York

Most UK students with an LLB will be eligible, provided the degrees are:

- **Single-honours law**
(Joint and combined degrees are sometimes accepted)
- **At least 3 years in duration (full time) or 4 years (part time)**
(Accelerated courses can be deemed ineligible)

Regrettably:

- **Distance learning degrees are not accepted by New York**
- **Graduate Diplomas in Law are not considered as equivalent of a law degree by New York**

California

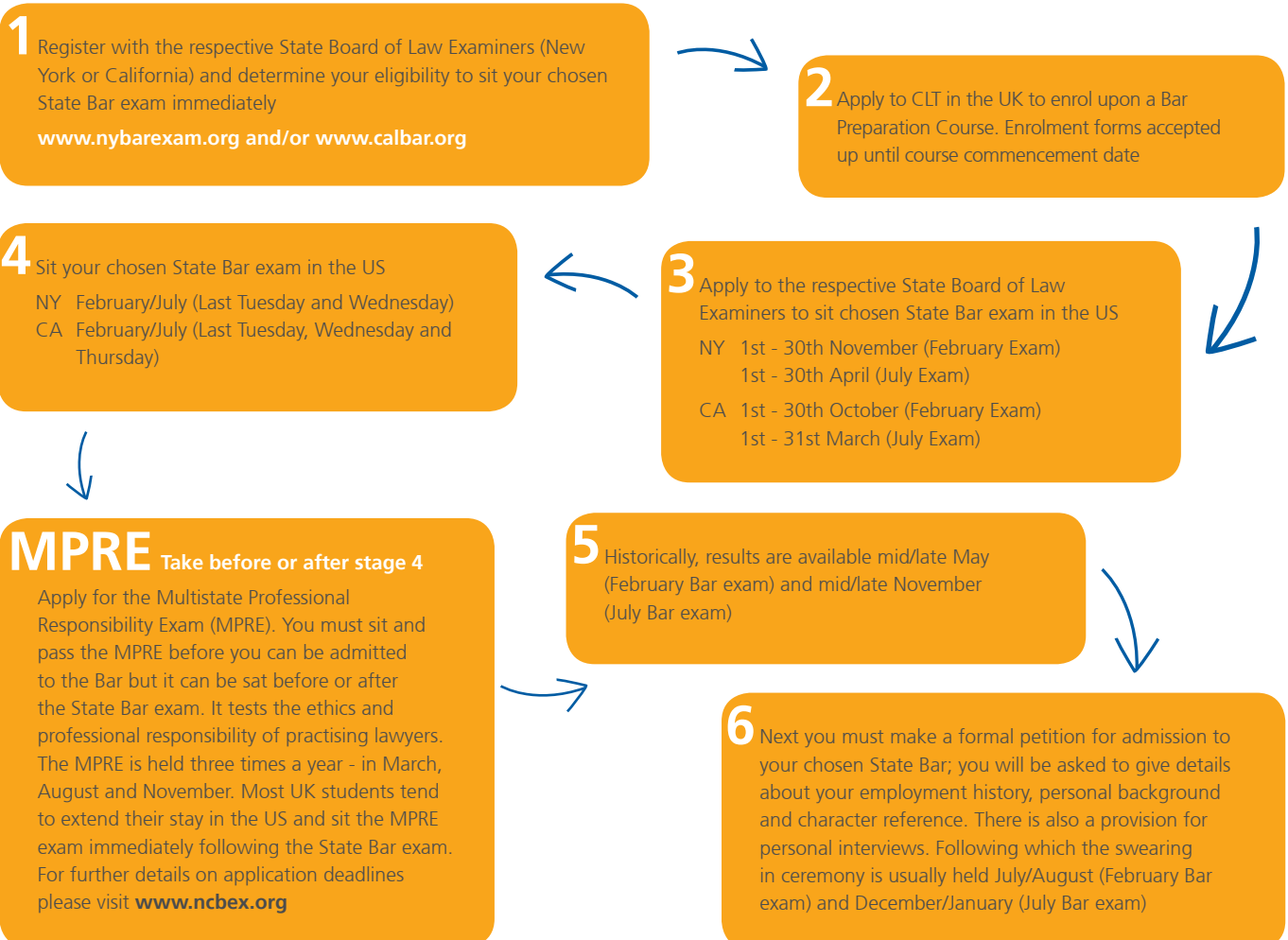
The California Bar is open to qualified solicitors and barristers of England & Wales and other common law countries. A law degree is not always necessary.
