From the M5

Leave the M5 at **Junction 31** and join the A30 to Okehampton

Take the first exit after 2 miles, signposted **Ide**. At the roundabout, take the first exit to Ide. After 0.7 of a mile turn left into the village of **Ide**.

Follow this road through the village and up the hill into the country. After approx 2.5 miles, you will see a **Telephone Box** on the left hand side. Take the next turning left, opposite a **Thatched Cottage**. Follow this road for 0.5 of a mile and immediately after going under a low **Stone Bridge**, turn left into the entrance drive of the Hotel.

(The total journey is approx 6 miles from the M5)

From the centre of Exeter

Follow the A30 signs to Okehampton/Plymouth, taking the road over the river Exe. Following the signs for Marsh Barton Trading Estate/Okehampton/Plymouth, proceed along this road through sets of traffic lights. When you pass Sainsbury's on your left, move into the middle lane, which becomes the right hand lane at the next set of traffic lights. At the major roundabout go straight across, following signs to **Ide**.

Follow this road through the village and up the hill into the country. After approx 2.5 miles, you will see a **Telephone Box** on the left hand side. Take the next turning left, opposite a **Thatched Cottage**. Follow this road for 0.5 of a mile and immediately after going under a low **Stone Bridge**, turn left into the entrance drive of the Hotel.

(The total journey is approx 5 miles from the centre of Exeter)

From the A38

(coming from Cornwall and South Devon)

On the A38 from Plymouth, when the **Devon and Exeter Race Course** is on your right, with a Petrol Station on your left, you will see a large sign to **Dunchideock** on your left. Turn left at the 'T' junction, and follow the road through the forest for approx 3 miles, going straight over any crossroads and passing the Belvedere Tower on your right. After passing the village signs, turn right opposite a **Thatched Cottage** with pillars supporting the roof. Follow this road for 0.5 of a mile and immediately after going under a low **Stone Bridge**, turn left into the entrance drive of the Hotel.

(The hotel is approx 10 minutes from the A38)

Drivers of large vehicles should contact the Hotel for an alternative route to avoid the low bridge

At the end of the long drive you will see the large Hotel car park. Conference Guests should enter through the Robert Adam Arch. Hotel Guests are advised to take the short walk to the Hotel Reception. If you require directions from other areas, please contact the Hotel.
